

In order to properly view this DVD please read the following:

On a TV:

- Be sure you have a DVD player capable of reading the following formats:
DVD-R, DVD+R, DVD-RW, DVD-RW

On a PC or Laptop:

If you are trying to view this on your computer be sure to check the following:

- You must have a DVD-ROM or DVD burner installed in your PC or laptop

*Note – Windows Users must download a special player in order to view DVDs.

Windows Media Player does support DVD playback, which can make it frustrating when trying to view DVDs. It is recommended to use a third-party media player such as "VideoLAN - VLC media player", which allows users to view a very wide range of video and DVD formats with no problems.

To download VLC Media Player visit:

- Click the link "Download Now for Windows"
- Save the file on your PC ("C:\Program Files")
- Once it has finished downloading, double click the downloaded 'VLC' file to install.
Once installed, you will be able to use VLC to play DVDs.
